Did you know that physical movement and exercise increases brain activity by approximately 10%?

## A WORD FROM THE NURSE

On **Wednesday, October 6<sup>th</sup>**, Boerne Acute Care Center and Little Spurs Pediatric Urgent Care will once again be conducting a Flu Clinic at Roan Forest. The clinic is scheduled from 7:15 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. They will be offering the nasal FluMist as well as the Flu shot vaccines. FluMist is recommended over the Flu shot for healthy people aged 2 to 49 who do not have any chronic health problems. Please refer to the CDC's information sheets that were sent home with students on Friday, September 24<sup>th</sup>. If you are not sure if your child is eligible to receive FluMist or have other questions or concerns, please contact Maria Meagher at 210-889-2112 or your private healthcare provider.

The cost per vaccination is \$25 for the shot and \$35 for the nasal FluMist. If you would like your child to participate, please send the completed forms and payment with your child on the day of the clinic. Parents, siblings and grandparents are also welcome to get vaccinated as long as their Flu vaccine supply is not limited.


